ANNEXURE-1**Assistant Professor (pay scale Rs. 57,700 – 1,82,400)****Qualifications and Guidelines:**

1. A Bachelor's degree in Veterinary Science/Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry /Dairy Science/Dairy Technology/Fisheries Science of respective discipline from SAU/SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized university.
2. A Master's degree with a minimum of 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST) (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned /Allied subject from SAU/SVU/Deemed University or any other recognized University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
3. The candidate must have cleared NET in the concerned subject conducted by the UGC/ICAR/CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M. Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Note: MSVE 2016 Regulations Section 14.1 reads "The persons with only basic Veterinary qualification, included in Schedules to the Act, registered with a State Veterinary Council and having a Post-graduate Degree in the concerned subject, shall be recruited as teaching faculty in the Veterinary Colleges and preference shall be given to the candidates who have qualified National Eligibility Test conducted by Agricultural Scientist Recruitment Board. Accordingly, the Candidates shall be considered for Selection only if he qualifies NET exam in the Concerned Subject Conducted by Agricultural Scientist Recruitment Board.

4. NET is exempted for such Master's degree programmes where NET is not conducted by ICAR/UGC/CSIR/SLET/SET in the concerned/Allied subjects.
5. NET is also exempted for those who obtained Ph.D degree from a foreign University/ Institution with a ranking among top 500 in the world University Ranking. However, such candidate has to fulfill the conditions given below as per the Government Order No.AHF113 VET 2018/Bangalore dated 16.3.2019.

Provided, the candidates for registered for the Ph.d Program Prior to July 11 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing regulations of the institution awarding the degree and such PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions

- a. The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode
- b. The Ph.D thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners.
- c. The Ph.D viva voce of the candidate has been conducted
- d. The candidate has been published **two research papers** from his/her Ph.D work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal
- e. The candidate has presented at least **two papers** based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored by the UGC/ICAR/ICSSR/CSIR or any other similar agency.

Note: The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean of University concerned.

6. Knowledge of Kannada is mandatory

Note: If candidate do not studied Kannada as a first or second or third language in S.S.L.C or

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its equivalent qualification, then the candidate shall be eligible for interview in respect of Assistant Professor post unless He/She qualifies in a test in Kannada language. This test shall comprise of one paper carrying a maximum of 150 marks. For qualifying in this paper, a candidate must secure a minimum of 50% marks. The standard of this paper shall be that of first language Kannada at S.S.L.C level)

Age Limit: The candidates should have not crossed **38 years** of age as on the last date of submission of application in case of **General Merit**, **41 years** of age in case of **OBC** category and **43 years** in case of **SC, ST and Cat – I** category candidates.

Age relaxation for any other case will be considered based on the order of the Govt. of Karnataka in vogue.
