Qualification(s):-

- M.V.Sc. /Ph.D. in the concerned subject awarded from recognized Veterinary/Agricultural Sciences University/Deemed Institutes.
- Candidate for Veterinary subjects must be compulsorily registered under the K.V.C. Act 1984
- Qualified in National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the competent Authority however NET is exempted or candidate who possess Ph.D.

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Terms and Condition:-

- The consolidated pay for the selected candidate will be paid Rs. 50,000/- per month
- The maximum period of contractual assignment is up to 16-05-2027 or post filled up on regular basis by the University or whichever is earlier.
- Knowledge of Kannada is mandatory
- The recruitment on a contract basis is purely temporary, and there will be no opportunity for regularization under any circumstance.
- Candidates applying on contract basis must compulsorily be residents of Karnataka
- Assistant Professors appointed on a contract basis will not be paid any allowance other than the fixed monthly salary.
- Assistant Professor selected on a contract basis must compulsorily perform their duties of the place of posting assigned to them.
- If a candidate appointed on contract basis wishes to resign from service midway, they must submit a request to the University one month in advance through higher officer.
- If a candidate appointed on a contract basis remains absent from duty without giving any intimation they shall refund at least one month salary to the University.
- If they remain absent from duty without authorization, whether for medical reasons or any other reason, without obtaining permission from the competent authority, their contract based appointment service shall be terminated.
- All losses that may be incurred by the University due to the misconduct or negligence of the said teaching staff selected on a contract basis shall be borne by the respective teaching staff to the University.
- Contract based teaching staff must strictly maintain the confidentiality of any official information that may become available or accessible to them while performing their duties.
- Teaching staff selected on a contract basis shall submit an undertaking in the prescribed format on a Rs. 100/- stamp paper to the concerned authority
- No TA/DA will be given to candidates appearing for interview.
